What is hyperbaric oxygen therapy?

Hyperbaric oxygen therapy (HBOT) is a simple, painless and effective treatment. During HBOT, patients breathe 100 percent oxygen inside a pressurized chamber. The treatment quickly delivers high concentrations of oxygen to the bloodstream. This therapy assists in the wound healing process and is effective in fighting certain types of infection. HBOT also stimulates the growth of new blood vessels and improves circulation.



Who is eligible for hyperbaric therapy?

For some patients, traditional wound healing can be enhanced using hyperbaric oxygen therapy. Ingham's hyperbaric oxygen chamber will be used to treat a variety of conditions for problem wounds:

- Osteomyelitis
- Radiation tissue damage
- Skin grafts and flaps
- Diabetic foot and leg wounds
- Diabetic ulcers
