

CATA Bus Service From MSU to the Ingham Regional Multi-Specialty Clinic

From MSU Campus to the Ingham Regional Multi-Specialty Clinic (2727 S. Pennsylvania Ave.):

- Catch **Route 1 - Downtown Lansing/Meridian Mall** at any CATA bus stop on Grand River Avenue between Bogue and Abbot or on Michigan Avenue between Grand River Avenue and Harrison Road. Be sure to be on the north side of the street where buses are traveling into downtown Lansing. If paying cash, ask for a transfer which you can use to pay for your ride on the next bus. Transfers are free.
- Take **Route 1 to Michigan & Pennsylvania Avenue**. Total travel time from MSU to Michigan & Pennsylvania is approximately 10 minutes. Go to the CATA bus stop on the west side of Pennsylvania, just south of Michigan Avenue, and **transfer to Route 8 - Pennsylvania/Holt**.
- Take **Route 8 and get off the bus on Pennsylvania Avenue** just before the traffic light at the street leading down to Ingham Regional Orthopedic Hospital. The Multi-Specialty Clinic is located on the second floor of Ingham Regional Orthopedic Hospital. You will have to walk in from Pennsylvania to the clinic. Total travel time from Michigan & Pennsylvania to the IRMC clinic is approximately 5-7 minutes. If you have a transfer, use it to pay for your ride on this bus.

Total travel time from MSU to the Ingham Regional Multi-Specialty Clinic is approximately 15-17 minutes. Allow an additional 20-25 minutes in the event you have to wait on Pennsylvania for the next Route 8 bus to arrive. Please note:

- Route 1 operates every 10-15 minutes Monday through Saturday until approximately 9PM, then every 20 minutes until 11:25PM.
- Route 8 operates every 25-30 minutes weekdays until 5:45PM, then every 45 minutes until 11:30PM. Because Route 8 does not run as frequently as Route 1, you may have to wait 5-20 minutes for the next Route 8 bus to arrive.

From the Ingham Regional Multi-Specialty Clinic to MSU Campus:

- Take **Route 8 - Pennsylvania/Holt** at the CATA bus stop on the east side of Pennsylvania Avenue. If paying cash, ask for a transfer when you board this bus. Use the transfer to pay for your next ride. Take Route 8 to Michigan & Pennsylvania. Total travel time from the Multi-Specialty Clinic to Michigan & Pennsylvania is approximately 5-7 minutes.
- On Michigan Avenue, **transfer to Route 1 - Downtown Lansing/Meridian Mall** at the CATA bus stop in front of Rite Aid. You may have to wait 5-10 minutes for the next Route 1 bus to arrive. If you have a transfer, use it to pay for your ride on this bus. Take Route 1 back to MSU. Get off the bus on either Michigan or Grand River Avenue.

Total travel time from the IRMC clinic to MSU is approximately 17-20 minutes. Allow an additional 5-10 minutes in the event you have to wait on Michigan for the next Route 1 bus to arrive.
